Position Summary: In close coordination with Plan International Pilipinas and ECPAT Ph focal persons for the Project, the Project Officer will be responsible for developing and implementing agreed workplans related to ECPAT Ph's role as lead and contributor in achieving project results; manage material and financial resources within the guidelines set by the project; collaborate with the two parties in undertaking monitoring and evaluation tasks required by the Project; and address implementation risks and challenges in achieving the intended outcomes of the project.

Key Functions and Responsibilities

In close coordination with Plan International Pilipinas and ECPAT Ph:

1. Act as the lead person in addressing ECPAT Ph's role as contributor and lead for specific results indicated in the project results framework, guided by the key outputs and indicators for the two project outcomes;
2. Develop a results-based plan based on ECPAT Ph's roles as contributor and lead, specifying key deliverables and timeframes, and resources needed for accomplishing the workplan;
3. Contribute to the development of the project monitoring, evaluation and learning plan as necessary, including methods of data collection, reporting and documenting verifiable data on project indicators (consult with Plan International Pilipinas), guided by the indicators in the project results framework;
4. Implement the agreed workplan for ECPAT's dual role as project contributor and lead; and provide regular feedback on the status of project implementation;
5. Elevate challenges to PLAN International Pilipinas and ECPAT Ph, with identified solutions for mitigating risks and addressing challenges creatively;
6. Prepare regular reports on project implementation as required;
7. Participate in regular meetings and all activities in line with ECPAT Ph's dual role as project contributor and lead;
8. Document lessons learned and potential good practices in the project
